Tarpon is searching for a Fitter to join our Structures team in Calgary, Alberta. The Fitter is responsible for the assembly and fitting of metal sections and plates to form complete units or sub-units using tack welding, bolting, riveting or other methods.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Studies engineering drawings and blueprints, determines the materials required and plans the sequence of tasks to cut metal most efficiently.
- Constructs patterns and templates as guides for layouts.
- Prepares materials prior to assembly.
- Lays out reference points and patterns on heavy metal according to component specifications.
- Rigs, hoists and moves materials to storage areas or within work site.
- Sets-up and operates various heavy-duty metal working machines such as cutting torches, grinders and drills, including computer numerical control (CNC) equipment to bend, cut form, punch, drill and form heavy metal components.
- Fits-up fabrication assembly to welding stage.
- Accurately torch cuts main members to size, if required.
- Details necessary pieces, if required.
- Installs fabricated components in final product.
- Completes quick precision layout of assembly.
- Completes housekeeping duties in assigned area or project area on a daily basis and/or when required.
- Complies with standards and procedures the Tarpon Health and Safety Manual and Occupational Health and Safety Regulations.

Skills, Abilities and Educational Background

- Completion of a 3 to 4 year apprenticeship program or a combination of over 3 years of work experience in the trade. Some college or industry courses in welding are usually required to be eligible for trade certification.
- Possesses a solid understanding of weld symbols.
- Ensures all required CWB qualifications are current.
- Experienced in creating left hand assembly from right hand views.
- Possesses the ability to read both imperial and metric measurements.
- Proficient in reading drawings.
- Possesses proper rigging and overhead crane skills.
- Experienced with material handling of fragile tack assemblies (long loads and tight turns).
- Possesses solid understanding of welding equipment and welding accessories.
- Possesses knowledge of pre-heat and post-heat temperatures and applications.
