Tarpon is searching for a Welder to join our Structures team in Calgary, Alberta. The Welder must have the ability to weld in all positions with good penetration and quality.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Reads and interprets blueprints or welding process specifications and welding symbols.
- Operates manual or semi-automatic welding equipment to fuse metal segments using processes such as gas metal arc welding (GMAW), flux-cored arc welding (FCAW), shielded metal arc welding (SMAW) and oxy-acetylene cutting (OAC).
- Removes welds using the Air Arc Gouging process.
- Completes assigned work within given timeframe and according to specifications.
- Accurately completes paperwork including, but not limited to: time sheets, weight sheets, hazard analysis sheets, etc.
- Operates manual or semi-automatic flame-cutting equipment.
- Repairs worn parts of metal products by welding on extra layers.
- Performs the maintenance and repairs of welding equipment.
- Adjusts welding equipment and tooling according to work specifications.
- Completes housekeeping duties in assigned area or project area on a daily basis and/or when required.
- Ensures assigned work is understood prior to commencing.
- Reports all non-conforming material to the department supervisor immediately.
- Complies with standards and procedures of Tarpon's Health and Safety Manual and Occupational Health and Safety Regulations.

Skills, Abilities and Educational Background

- Completion of a three year apprenticeship program or a combination of over three years of work experience in the trade. Some college or industry courses in welding are usually required to be eligible for trade certification.
- Welders may specialize in certain types of welding such as custom fabrication, structural construction welding or machinery and equipment repair welding.
- Ensures all required CWB qualifications are current.
- Possesses solid understanding of welding equipment and welding accessories.
- Possesses knowledge of pre-heat and post-heat temperatures and applications.
