Duties and Responsibilities

- Coordinates and maintains Tarpon's Quality Control program and manuals.
- Verifies heat numbers/tracking numbers of plates, pipes and attachments for material identification and traceability.
- Reviews dimensional tolerances and orientation of attachments (nozzles, saddles, etc.) as per drawings.
- Conducts inspection of individual scope of work in progress and at completion.
- Coordinates, compiles and files all documents from the various projects.
- Ensures that all requirements of the Quality Control program are completed in a timely manner.
- Coordinates document and quality control to ensure quality assurance goals are maintained.
- Assists in determining processes and process improvement.
- Executes the inspection and signoff of projects as per the Inspection Test Plan (ITP).
- Documents processes to ensure overall project consistency.
- Maintains relationships with third party inspectors.
- Coordinates all subcontractors for non-destructive examination and post weld heat treatment.
- Controls all welder records and logs.
- Verifies welding is completed as per approved CWB QWP.
- Provides quality control updates at production meetings as required.
- Complies with standards and procedures of the Tarpon Health and Safety manual and Occupational Health and Safety regulations.

- Must have practical knowledge of supervising welding/fitting operations.
- CET (welding) or equivalent experience.
- Must have three or more years experience in a quality control field.
- Possesses conversant knowledge of CWB requirements.

- Must be familiar with NDE test procedures.
- Must have advanced knowledge of Quality Control procedures, record keeping and systems.
